## CURRICULUM

EdOptions Academy offers a diverse curriculum that aligns with national standards. Course offerings include a wide range of courses offered at various levels of rigor. Our core curriculum is aimed to prepare students for college and the workplace. EdOptions Academy curriculum and instructional is approved by the NCAA. We offer many Honors and AP courses.

AP® courses are offered: Biology, Calculus AB, Chemistry, Computer Science, English Literature and Composition, and United States History. AP world language and culture courses offered include French, and Spanish. AP is an open-enrollment program.

Honors classes offered: Algebra I, Algebra II, Biology, Calculus, Chemistry, English 9, English 10, English 11, English 12, Geometry, High School Earth Science, Physics, Precalculus, US History, and World History.

## GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

EdOptions Academy operates on a semester system. One-half high school credit is earned for each semester of a course. Students that completed high school courses while in middle school may have been granted high school credit for the course. Students generally take six classes per semester.
